





Rooted in dissatisfaction with personal experiences as scholarly authors.




OA landscape in 2008 was relatively sparse, with only one such book publisher in the UK, Open Humanities Press.



OUR PUBLISHING MODEL

- Open Access and Free Publishing: OBP provides permanent and free access to books without requiring authors to pay Open Access fees (BPCs), promoting wider dissemination of knowledge.
- Authorship and Copyright Control: OBP offers authors full copyright control and faster publishing times and all our books are publised under a CC license, enhancing accessibility and author empowerment.
- Multiple Formats and Editions: Books are published simultaneously in digital formats (PDF, HTML) and affordable paperback, hardback, and ebook editions (EPUB), catering to diverse reader preferences.
- Sustainable Funding Model and Increased Impact: OBP sustains itself through a mixed model of funding without imposing mandatory Open Access fees, leading to greater readership, citations, and potential for translation and reuse, while supporting innovative publication modes.



OUR REVENUE STREAMS



Library Membership Programme:

This stream accounts for slightly over a third of the total revenue.




Title Grants: About one-third of income comes from grants and donations.

Authors may apply for funding to cover publication costs, enabling those without resources to publish. OBP also earns grants through its involvement in open-access software and publishing projects.




Sales from print and EPUB copies: Revenue is also generated from the sales of printed and EPUB copies of the our books.







Aims to remove financial barriers to both authorship and readership.







Since its establishment in 2015, the Library Membership Programme has over 250 members worldwide.


The benefits include:
